

**Msgr. William G. Cunneen and Fr. Donald Proulx Scholarship Program**  
**Sponsored by Knights of Columbus Council 10020 Windham**

1. Scholarships in the name of Msgr. Cunneen and Fr. Proulx will be granted this year by Knights of Columbus Council 10020 Windham
2. The value of the scholarships will be established by the council prior to announcement of the application process for that year. This year, two scholarships will be awarded to fund Catholic High School education and two for college. If the number of applicants/ awardees in either category is less than two, then the council may elect to provide the additional scholarship(s) to the other category.
3. **Eligibility:** Active parishioners, daughters, sons or grandchildren of parishioners of Our Lady of Perpetual Help parish.
4. **Requirements:** Interested students must complete an application form including attached essays and submit official high school or college transcripts and mail to the scholarship committee.
5. **Criteria:** Application will be judged on the following:
  - Academic achievement
  - Extracurricular, community, and parish activities/involvement
  - Student Essays
6. **Selection Process:** A committee of three Knights, exclusive of any Knight who may have a competing daughter or son, shall determine scholarship awards. The council will choose the committee, but will not participate in the application review or decision-making process. The Grand Knight or Scholarship Director has the responsibility to announce the awards each year and for coordinating the program.
7. **Dates:** Applications received by June 30, 2017 will be considered. Announcement of awards will be made by July 30, 2017.
8. **Award Presentation:** Scholarship funds will be presented after satisfactory completion of the first semester and enrollment in the second semester of the next school year.
